Fiscal year 2022 (July 1, 2021 - June 30, 2022) was a time of transition from pandemic restrictions to safely resuming in-person library visits and programming. We were thrilled to see old friends return and to welcome new members of the community. We take great pride in being one of the first places new residents visit and providing exceptional service to each person who enters our Library.

Our staff attended the lowa Libraries Online Conference in January and were inspired by the idea of community partnerships. We collaborated with Solon Senior Support to create our weekly Coffee & Conversations and Chair Yoga programs. We worked with the Solon Volunteer Fire Department to provide an up close look at a fire truck, local Master Gardeners to create a library garden, and the lowa City Bird Club to lead a bird watching expedition. We partnered with Solon Recreation to host Family Fun Nights with games and a movie every second Saturday and participated in their annual Trunk or Treat event. We coordinated our summer storywalks and co-hosted the Local Libraries LIT virtual author events with our fellow Johnson County Libraries. We encouraged your creativity by hosting a community mural on our patio and a pumpkin decorating contest.

We are proud to be leading by example with the installation of our 100 roof-mounted solar panels. Since their installation in July 2021, we have realized significant energy savings and contributed to the health of our environment. Each month of the year we provided learning opportunities with engaging programming for all ages and enjoyed sharing new experiences with our patrons.

We are so grateful for each of our amazing volunteers who serve our Library Community from weekly library projects to serving on one of our three supporting boards. We are delighted to be a place of learning and inspiration for our Community.
